CITY OF BOWIE, MD: Waiver, Release and Disclaimer of Liability and Indemnification Agreement

I, the undersigned, acknowledge and agree that I use the Bowie Ice Arena at my sole risk and that the City of Bowie, and its servants, agents, employees and officials, including the directors of the Bowie Figure Skating Club, shall not be liable to me for any claims, demands, injuries, damages, actions, or causes of action whatsoever, to my person or property arising out of or in connection with my use of or presence at the Bowie Ice Arena and/or any services or programs offered at the Bowie Ice Arena, whether offered by the City of Bowie or by a third party. Further, I do expressly hereby forever waive, release and discharge the City of Bowie, and its servants, agents, employees, and officials, including the directors of the Bowie Figure Skating Club, from all claims, demands, liabilities, injuries, damages, actions, or courses of action, by me and from all acts of active or possible negligence on the part of the city of Bowie, and/or its servants, agents or employees, including the directors of the Bowie Figure Skating Club, against me, arising out of or in connection with my use of or presence at the Bowie Ice Arena or participation in any services or programs offered at the Bowie Ice Arena, whether offered by the City of Bowie or by a third party. I further agree that I will indemnify and hold the City of Bowie, and its servants, agents, employees and officials, including the directors of the Bowie Figure Skating Club, harmless from and against any and all claims, demands, liabilities, injuries, damages, loss, expense, actions, or property damage or personal injury sustained by myself or third persons as a consequence of the negligence or willful misconduct or alleged negligence or willful misconduct in the use of or presence at the Bowie Ice Arena and/or participation in any services or programs offered at the Bowie Ice Arena by myself or my minor child.

Consent for Participation

I hereby grant permission for my child to participate in the activities of the Bowie Figure Skating Club and certify that my child is physically capable of participating in those activities. I understand that the Club, its officers, members, professionals, coaches and agents assume no responsibility for injuries incurred during the participation in Club Activities. As in any athletic program, I realize that the possibility of injury exists. I understand that reasonable precautions will be made to prevent injuries from happening. I understand that my picture may be used in club publications, advertisements and promotion in print or on the club web page. I further understand that it is my responsibility to notify the club in writing if I want to revoke or restrict my permission to use my photograph.

Authorization for Medical Treatment

I authorize the BFSC through its professionals and supervising officers or agents to secure medical care and treatment for me/my child which may be medically necessary in the event of illness or injury during participation in Club activities.

Release Liability

I recognize that neither rink staff nor BFSC officers, board members, professionals, coaches and agents are responsible for my child before, after or during Club Activities. I assume responsibility for picking up my child immediately after any Club activity. In recognition of the fact that I/my child may be injured during Club activities, I expressly assume the risk of such injury. I release and discharge the BFSC, its officers, members, professionals, coaches and agents from any and all claims and damages for personal injury and/or property damage which may arise from or out of my/my child's participation in club activities, including but not limited to instruction, use of ice, and participation in ice shows, both on the ice and off.

Consent to abide by rules and Regulations

I hereby agree to abide by the bylaws of the BFSC and to observe the Code of Conduct, rules, policies of the BFSC, and to observe ice etiquette and courtesy at all times. I also agree to observe all rules, policies, and procedures of the United Figure Skating Association and any rules of the Bowie Ice Rink during Club sessions at the rink. I understand that failure to abide by these rules may result in loss of membership.

Code of Conduct 2010-2011 Skating Year

Due to certain trends in youth sports whereby both Parents and Members are letting their emotions manifest themselves in abusive and sometimes physical violence, Bowie Figure Skating Club supports a zero tolerance policy for unsportsmanlike behavior. Its Members, Coaches and Parents (if Member is under 18 years old) should continually raise the standard of behavior – both on and off the ice. Membership in the Bowie Figure Skating Club is a privilege and should carry a sense of pride. Participation in programs offered will require that members and parents (of Members under 18 years old) accept certain responsibilities.

Members Responsibilities:

- I will not verbally or physically abuse any of my fellow members, other USFSA members, USFSA officials, club Board members, volunteers, or coaches.
- I understand that poor sportsmanship, on or off ice, will not be tolerated.

Parents/Guardian Responsibilities:

- I will encourage sportsmanship by showing positive support for all members, coaches, Board members and other officials during all on and off ice sessions.
- I will encourage my child to treat all other members, coaches, Board members, other member's parents and other officials with respect.
- I will refrain from coaching my child or "manipulate" other Members during any on and off ice sessions.
- I will not verbally or physically abuse any club members (including my own child), coaches, club Board members, officials, other member parents, or volunteers.
- I will represent myself positively and not undermine the authority of coaches, club Board members, officials, or other club volunteers.

Course of Action:

Should a parent or Member not adhere to the above, the BFSC Board of Directors holds the Member and/or parent accountable and the Board of Directors is empowered to take necessary action. Actions could be as simple as a verbal warning to the parent or Member up to disciplinary hearings before the Board of Directors leading to suspension or expulsion from the Bowie Figure Skating Club and/or reporting to US Figure Skating that the member is "not in good standing".

Implementation:

Anyone may file a complaint, in writing and signed, to the President of Bowie Figure Skating Club.

_____ **FUND RAISING:** Approach local businesses for support, such as advertising on our website, donating money, sponsoring an event, etc.

_____ **TEST SESSION JUDGES HOSPITALITY:** Purchase food, setup room, and cleanup.

_____ **TEST SESSION MONITOR:** Check skaters into the session and onto the ice.
